#### **The Knights of Columbus**

On March 29<sup>th</sup> 1882 the Knights of Columbus obtained its state charter. It was founded by a parish priest, Fr. Michael J. McGivney, curate

at St. Mary's parish in New Haven, Conn. along with a small group of men.

Many Catholic men were working and living in



unfavorable conditions. And many, tragically, were dying young, leaving behind widows and orphans with insufficient financial resources. Fr. McGivney was convinced that there was a way to change the ending and brought the Catholic men in his parish together in mutual aid by establishing the Knights of Columbus with a "pass-thehat" insurance system. The rest is history.

#### After 134 years: Worldwide **Organization**

Today the Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic lay organization, with over 1.9 million members in the United States. Canada, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Cuba, the Philippines, the Bahamas, and Poland. In 2015, the Knights donated more than \$175 million and over 73.4 million hours of volunteer time to charity.

Council 12402 was founded at St. James Cathedral on March 25, 1999 with 38 Charter Members and now have over **170** members.
