Sr. Barrios retired on January 18, 2017 after 17 years of service to our community. The school came together to celebrate his dedication to Catholic education and to the students of St. James.

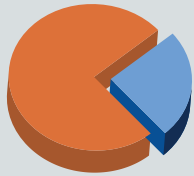

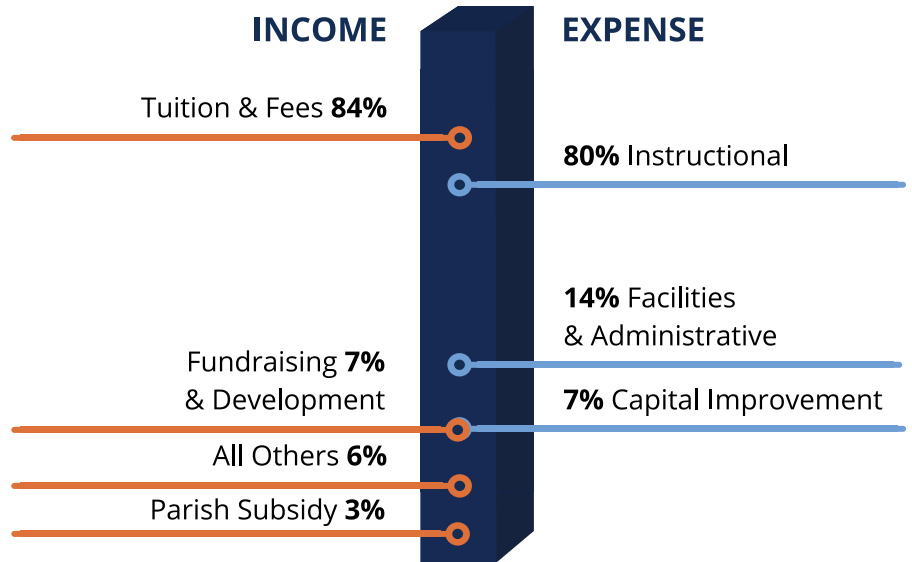

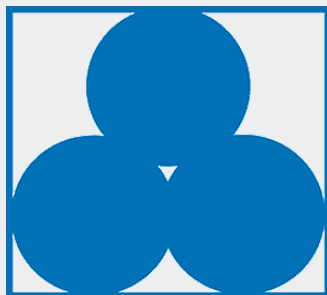
# ANNUAL FUND LETTER
