GIRL SCOUTS BRONZE AWARD

The Bronze Award is the highest honor a Junior Girl Scout can achieve and nine girls from SJCS's Troop 161 earned this distinction in April. Returning for the 2020-2021 school year, spirit banners can be used as an advertising space for a business/company or to wish your child best of luck all year long!


Banners are hung in Alumni Hall and can be purchased for a two or four year term. Funds raised go towards the




ST. JAMES SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP ENDOWMENT FUND




