## *PANTHERS LIVING OUT OUR SCHOOL MOTTO*



### GIRL SCOUTS BRONZE AWARD

The Bronze Award is the highest honor a Junior Girl Scout can achieve and nine girls from SJCS's Troop 161 earned this distinction in April. The Troop worked together, spending 45 hours, to create 75 pieces of artwork for the residents of Palmetto Landing Senior Center, an assisted living and memory care center in Winter Springs. Canvas paintings, paper flowers, 3-D art, and letters were donated to decorate the rooms of residents and uplift spirits during the pandemic.



### NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

NJHS students hosted several service opportunities during the year including a donut sale, the creation of a Wall of Heroes for Veterans Day, and donating snacks to first responders.



### CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK

During Catholic Schools Week, SJCS students took time to thank our dedicated service men and women for their service with letters and artwork. The campaign was held in conjunction with Operation Gratitude which provides civilians anywhere in America a way to say "Thank You" through active, hands-on volunteerism.



### BLANKET MAKING FOR HOMELESS

During the month of December, SJCS partnered with the Cathedral to donate the monies collected during School Masses to the parish's Blanket/Winter Item collection. Our Intermediate teachers, lead by Ms. Zimmerman, taught our students how to make no-sew blankets which were also donated to the Cathedral.
