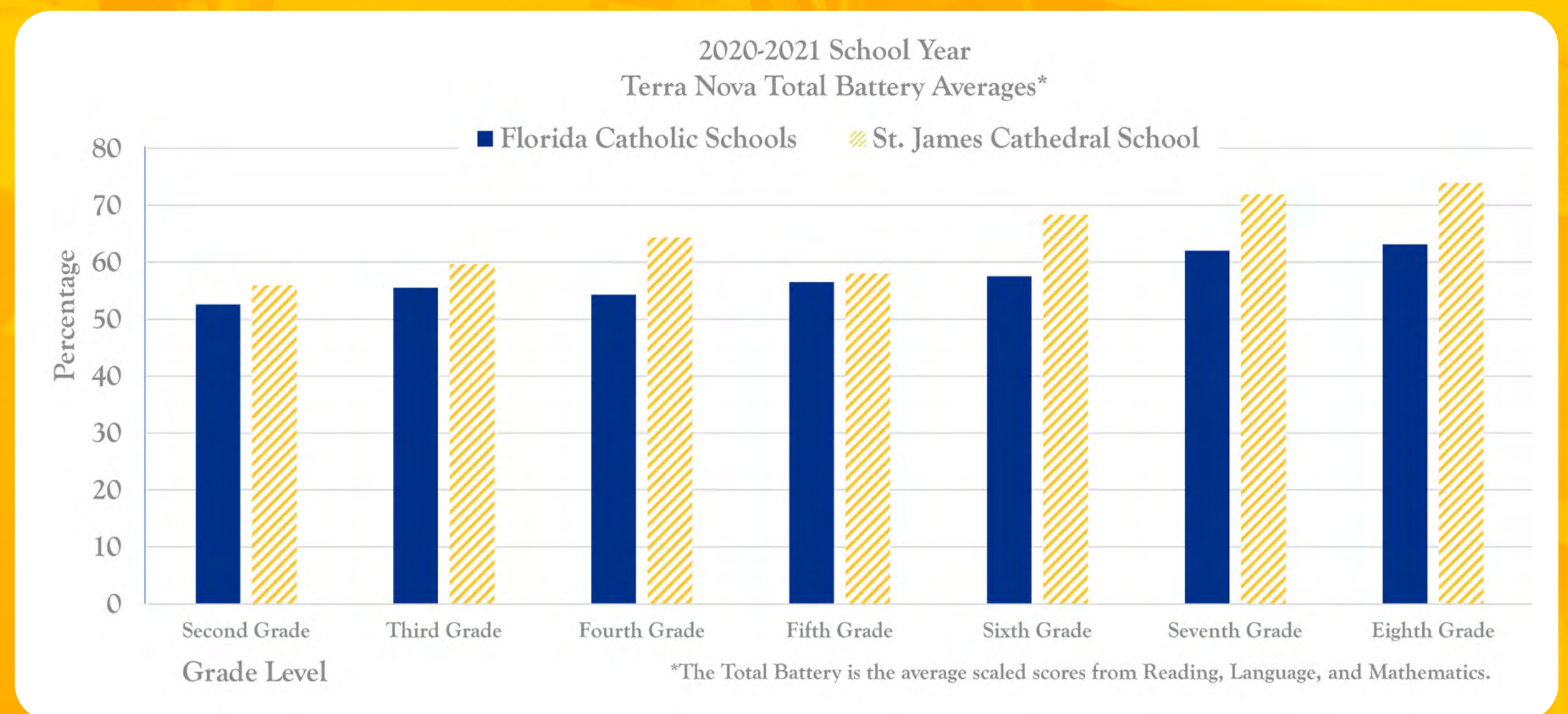

Honoring Veterans

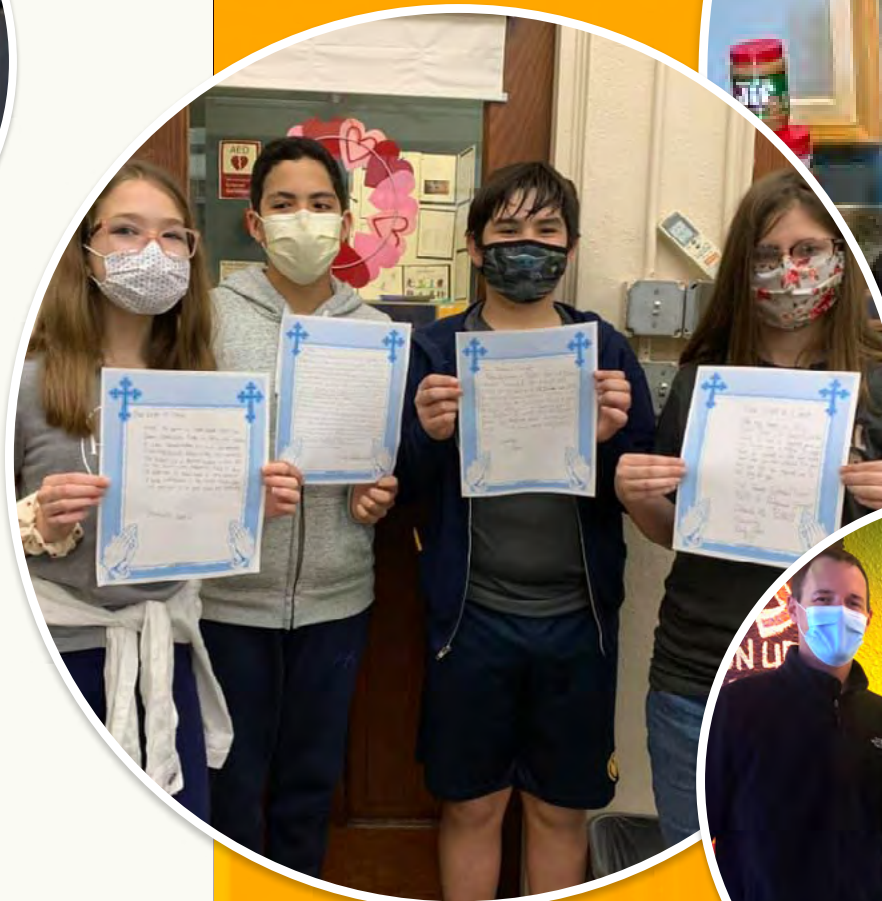

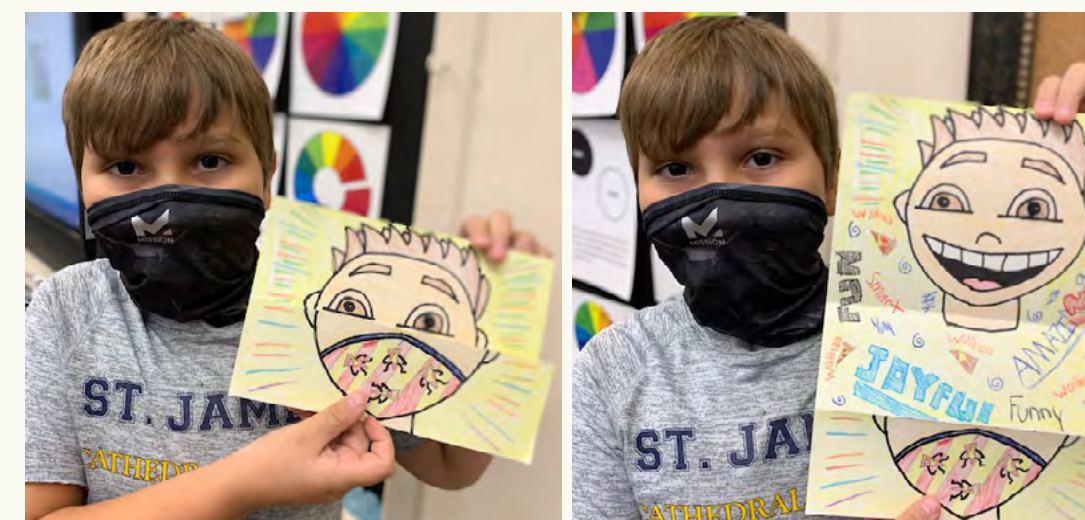
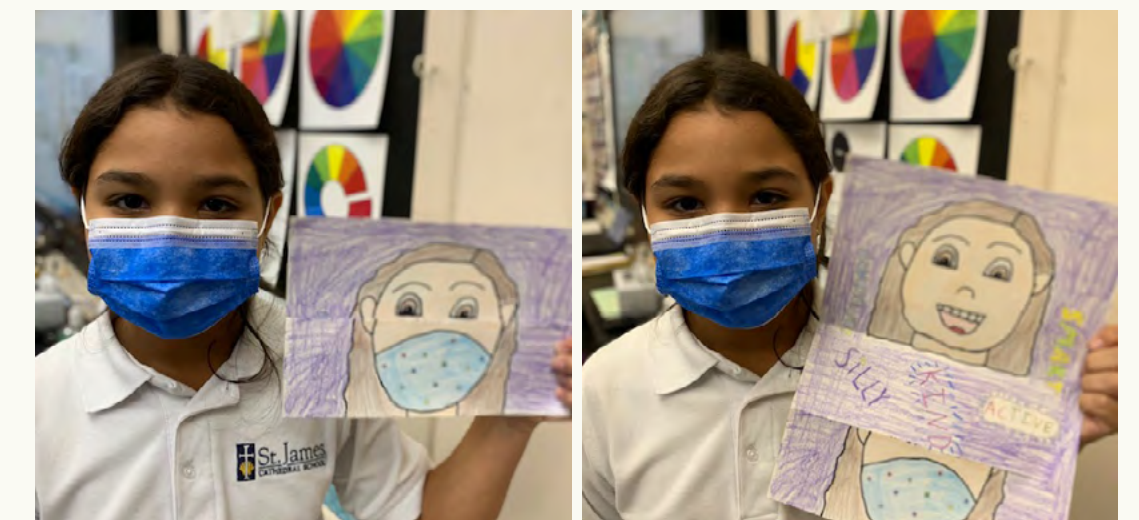
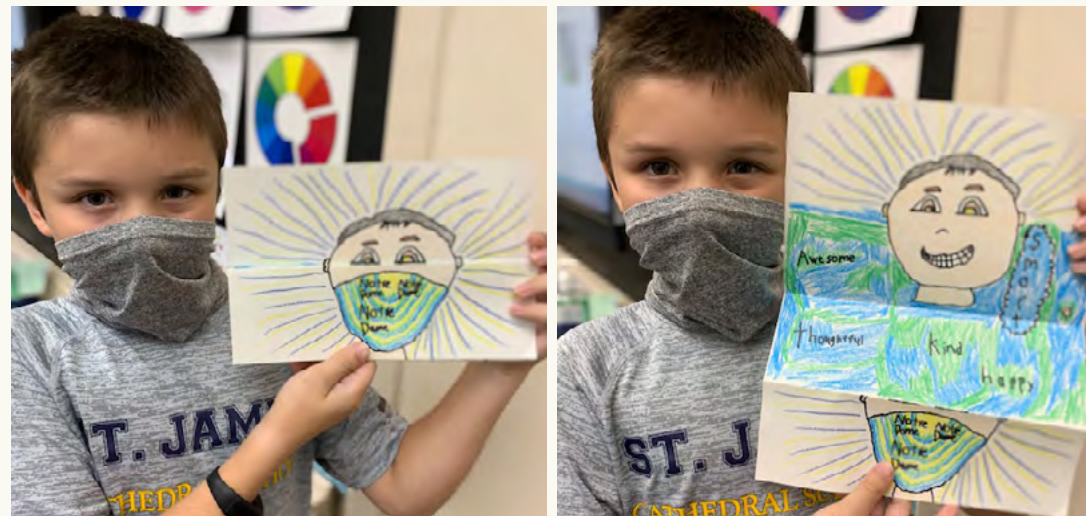
During Catholic Schools Week, the students focused on ways we can share love with our community—local and global.

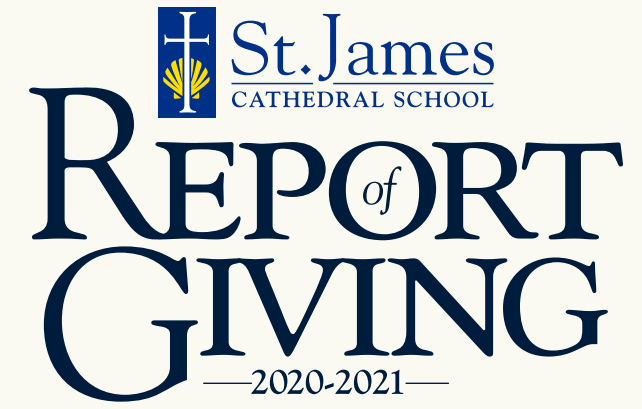
