

## CAMP DETAILS AT-A-GLANCE

- **COST:** \$250/week per camper (PK4 - 8th); a \$50 non-refundable deposit is due at registration per week
- **HOURS:** 8:00am - 5:00pm
- **Due to space constraints, Camp Panther is only open to SJCS students currently enrolled (21-22 school year) and space is limited.**
- Two snacks will be provided daily.
- Campers must bring a lunch and a water bottle (clearly labeled with their name) daily.

### Week 1: June 13 - 17 (STEM)

#### Wonder Works

Get ready for a week of exploration, experiments, and hands-on fun! Campers will learn about STEM careers, code Lego mazes, make clouds in a jar, magnetic slime, sugar crystals and more! The wacky week will include a trip to Wonder Works!

### Week 2: June 20 - 24 ("Wide World of Sports")

#### Mascot Games at the Amway Center

Sports fanatics and novices alike will enjoy a week of learning about and playing different sports. Hosted by trained coaches, campers will practice fundamentals and hone their skills. A highlight of the week will certainly be the Mascot Games!

### Week 3: June 27 - July 1 (Red, White, & Blue)

#### The History Center

Let's celebrate the USA's birthday by having a "Party in the USA!" Campers will "travel" from state to state exploring and learning while doing fun and creative activities! A walk to the History Center will illuminate Florida's history as part of the USA!

### Week 4: July 5 - 8\* (Willy Wonka) \*4-day week- \$200

#### Chocolate Kingdom Factory & Walk for Ice Cream

What a "sweet" week it will be! Campers will learn about the history of chocolate and the process to make the treat! We'll make fudge, chocolate slime, and watch Willy Wonka! The fun culminates with an adventure tour at the Chocolate Kingdom Factory and a walk to get ice cream!
