<p><u>STEM Computer Science Lab</u> Students in this course will be creating and learning about different games and designs such as “Ski Run” using MakeCode Arcade. They will create a coding platform that will have their skier move around mountains to avoid obstacles. Students will also participate in a Coding Bootcamp using Scratch 3.0. They will learn the basics and fundamentals of Scratch and will be challenged to create their very own game. During our 3D printing session, the students will design a “Vroom Car” with help from the instructor.
