

### EIGHTH GRADE RETREAT

Each year the 8<sup>th</sup> grade class attends a fall one-day, spiritual retreat that is generally held off campus.

The Religion teachers coordinate the details of the retreat. The cost of the retreat (lunch and snack included) is covered in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade fees.

### **CLASS T-SHIRT**

Eighth grade students submit designs for the class t-shirt. The 8th grade class votes to determine the design and motto. The t-shirts are considered an eighth grade privilege. The t-shirt is generally worn on the retreat, field trips, and informal gatherings throughout the school year so as to define an 8th grader from other students.




- The Middle School dances (winter and spring) are coordinated by the 8<sup>th</sup> grade parents and school staff.
  - Parents and staff members chaperone. All chaperones must be fingerprinted and approved by the Diocese of Orlando. Chaperone names must be submitted to the school office 72 hours prior to each dance.
  - Parents are responsible for decorations, set-up, clean-up, snacks and drinks.
- The school hires the DJ and coordinates the DJ payment.
- Dance fees (\$10-20) are collected at the door of the event.
- Cell phones are confiscated during the event but returned at the end of the dance.
- Dance dates, generally two dances per year, are calendared by the school and posted on the monthly school calendar.

#### PICTURES AND DVD

\*An 8X10 class picture (cost included in 8th Grade Fee) with the graduates in gowns, is coordinated and taken by a professional photography company.



- \*Parents coordinate an 8<sup>th</sup> grade video including pictures of the graduate as a baby, of sacramental events, accomplishments, etc...
  - The video is played at the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Luncheon.



### **YEARBOOK DEDICATION**

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade families often purchase an advertisement in the St. James yearbook in order to express their sentiments and congratulations to the graduating students. The cost for advertisements is <u>not</u> included in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade fees.
- Information for the dedication page is communicated each year in the fall.

### GOWNS, DIPLOMAS AND COVERS

- **✓ SJCS gowns are mandatory for the class picture and graduation.**
- Gowns are supplied by the school (measurements are taken in the spring).
  - Girls and boys wear royal blue gowns

The diploma and cover are provided by school.

### 8<sup>TH</sup> GRADE CLASS TRIP

- Graduates generally go to Islands of Adventure (IOA) for their final class field trip.
- Chaperones are needed but they must be fingerprinted and pay their own way. Season passes may be used by chaperones only (no passes can be used for 8th grade students).
- Approximate cost (\$100) reflects current entrance fee prices (group rate) and bus transportation. This amount does not include meals, souvenirs or other individual purchases.

### **GRADUATION LUNCHEON**

The 8<sup>th</sup> graders vote on a luncheon of their choice. The food is served by parents after the graduation practice the day before the Candlelight Mass and Graduation Ceremony. The 8<sup>th</sup> grade video is played for the students during the luncheon.



# CANDLELIGHT CEREMONY

- The Candlelight Ceremony is scheduled at 9:00am on the school calendar. This special ceremony is a highpoint for graduates to pass on their "LIGHT" of leadership to the 7<sup>th</sup> grade class.
- The entire school as well as parents, grandparents, family members, etc., are welcome to attend this special ceremony and join in our celebration.
- Graduation gowns are worn over Church appropriate clothes.

## GRADUATION MASS

The SJCS Graduation Mass takes place at the St. James Cathedral at 9:45am, immediately following the Candlelight Ceremony.

Information regarding seating is emailed in the spring.

Students are required to report to the Cathedral by 8:45am. Gowns are worn over Church appropriate clothing.

Diplomas are presented after the Mass.
